About Work Experience

Work experience is available at Austal all times throughout the year.

Students can be accommodated in the following placement types:

- ◆ Day release - One day per week for up to 20 weeks

Prior to commencing their placement, each student will take part in a site safety induction where they will be provided with a safety helmet and glasses to use while working with us. During all placements, students are allocated a supervisor and a dedicated tradesperson.
