Requirements

To take part in Austal's work experience program, candidates must be of at least Year 11 school age and have an ability to meet the below criteria:

- ◆ Ability to understand directions and follow instructions
- ◆ Ability to commence work experience at 6am
- ◆ Show a genuine interest in the selected trade

Trade Opportunities

Fabrication and Welding - Pre-fabrication, fabrication and welding of steel and aluminium components and includes construction of vessels for the defence and commercial markets

Electrical - Installing, commissioning, altering, repairing and maintaining electrical systems designed to provide heat, light, power and control

Marine Fitout (Cabinet Making) - Fitting out the interiors on all types of vessels working with aluminium honeycomb light-weight panels, various types of flooring and ceiling systems

Marine Fitting (Engineering) - Fitting and assembling parts and sub-assemblies made from metal and other materials to make production machinery and other equipment and work on all aspect from installation of main equipment and pipe work through to testing and commissioning
